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LIVER CAKE TREATS

INGREDIENTS

250g liver
125g oat flour/oats
2 large eggs
2 cloves of garlic

METHOD



Preheat the oven to 180 °C, 350 °F or Gas 4. Line a greased cake tin or tray with greaseproof paper. Roughly chop the liver and whizz it in a food processor or blender. Add the flour, eggs and garlic cloves to the liquidised liver and whizz a second time.

Pour the mixture into your lined tray and put it in the oven to cook for 30 to 40 minutes. You will know when it's cooked because the cake should just bounce back a little when you prod the top. Take it out of the oven and leave to cool on a wire rack. When the cake is cold, remove it from the tin and cut into small squares. Portion it up into bags and freeze.

If liver is too rich for your dog you can make a tuna cake instead.

TUNA CAKE TREATS

Drain a 250g can of tuna (tuna in sunflower oil works better in a food processor), blitz it in the blender or processor, then add the rest of the ingredients and repeat as for the liver cake.
